

# Plaistow Hub Case Study

Soils, composts and plants for an inner city urban regeneration scheme

## The Project

Plaistow Hub is a new community hub in East London. The local centre was developed next to Plaistow Underground Station, creating a new piazza and streetscape. Alongside two separate residential buildings the project includes a new library, neighbourhood centre, supermarket, gym and café.

## The Brief

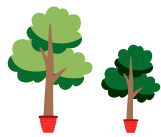

The aim was to offer an attractive and lush streetscape with trees and plants, in raised beds, borders and roof terraces. The team were also keen to put in place an effective muckaway process as part of the construction phase.

Ornamental bark

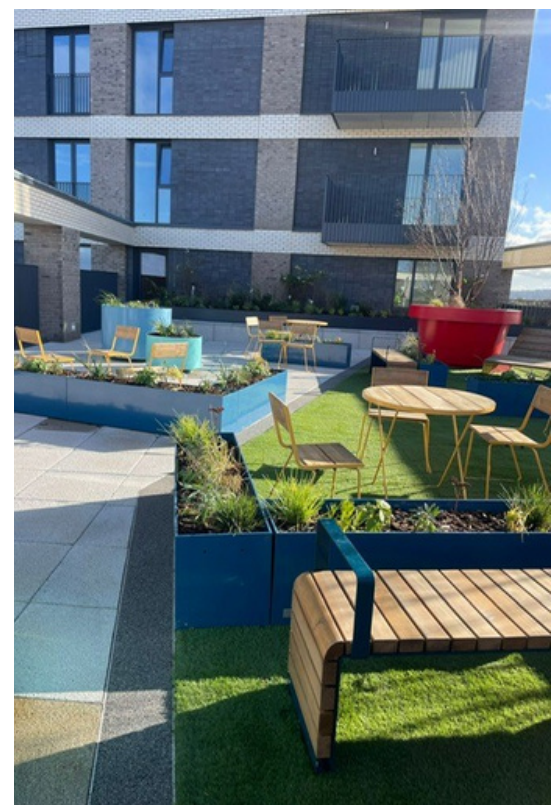


30 muckaway loads

## The Outcome



Plaistow Hub was completed in early 2024. Following the build phase the project was topped off with striking soft landscaping using our quality soil, trees and plants, creating a strong aesthetic in the new community hub.
